The Arts Concentration and The Skybridge Art Space at Eugene Lang College celebrate the thirtieth year of publication of PAJ - A Journal of Performance and Art, with an exhibition drawn from the journal archives. PAJ was founded by Bonnie Marranca and Gautam Dasgupta in 1976, and continues under the editorship of Bonnie Marranca who is a full-time faculty member in the Arts at Eugene Lang College / The New School. The exhibition highlights the connections between the artists and scholars who have appeared in PAJ, the avant-garde heritage of the New School, and the new Arts curriculum at Eugene Lang College which continues this legacy of experimentation in the arts. It showcases original PAJ issues, artists' writings and documentary photographs, and other archival materials from New York City and around the world.

PAJ charts new directions in performance, media, and the visual arts. PAJ is known internationally for its critical thought and cutting-edge explorations.
